



Space2 Gallery, Watford Museum 2015

Space2 Gallery is located on the 1st floor of Watford Museum, 194 Lower High Street, WD17 2DT

Watford Museum is housed in the former offices of Benskins Brewery, the museum has displays of local history and industry.

In 2006 part of Watford Museum was transformed with the help of the Friends of Watford Museum into a light, modern art gallery.

Space2 Gallery aims to

- Provide a platform for new and innovative visual art, showcasing local and national artists, providing a platform to launch or further their career
- Raise the profile of Watford as a town that is supportive of the visual arts
- Provide artists with exhibition opportunities in a supportive and flexible environment
- To encourage existing and new audiences to develop their engagement with the arts

The exhibition space has approximately 25 metres hanging space. The space is also suitable for 3D artwork as there is a large amount of floor space for plinths etc (these would have to be provided by the exhibiting artist)

Watford Museum and Space2 gallery is open Thursday – Saturday between 10am and 5pm.

Submissions for the Space2 Gallery are now open. We are looking for 5 artists / groups to exhibit in 2015

Short listing and selection will take place later that week with applicants being informed by 16th January 2015.

Decisions will be made by a panel of arts professionals. Decisions made by the panel will be final and no discussions will be entered into.
