**Watford Museum are looking for artists and craftsmen to exhibit at the Little Gallery Tearoom, which takes place every fourth Saturday of the month. The tearoom has a lovely vintage vibe, with home-made cakes and fair-trade drinks sold from an original Benskins bar! Your stall will be at the heart of the café, surrounded by the fantastic historical collections of the museum. Each tearoom also hosts an adult workshop, adding to the creative atmosphere.**

The tearoom runs from 10.30am – 4pm every fourth Saturday of the month. Our first tearoom is on Saturday 24 January. We do not charge for stalls, but cover our costs by taking 10% commission on any sales you make on the day. We cater for all forms of creativity, and have had exhibitors who specialise in jewellery, illustration, painting, prints, pottery, knitting, bookbinding and embroidery, just to name a few!

### **Interested in running a workshop?**

**Every month the tearoom also hosts an adult workshop to increase interest in the arts and crafts around Watford. In the past workshops have included felt making, embroidery, jewellery beading and paper crafts.**

We are now looking for artists and crafters to run workshops for our 2015 tearoom. We are open to the possibility of a variety of different artistic themes and skills. We normally require the workshop to run for 1 – 2 hours either in the morning or afternoon on the tearoom day. The venue is free of charge and you must provide all the materials yourself. To cover your costs we recommend charging a small amount to participants, of which the museum takes no commission.

For both the tearoom and the workshop, the museum will provide all of the marketing and booking requirements.
